The High Environmental Value Certification (H.V.E) has been awarded to Domaine Faiveley

Domaine Faiveley is committed to a sustainable approach to viticulture. This approach attests to the Faiveley family's close relationship with the Burgundian terroirs, their wish to preserve these terroirs and also their desire to keep their environmental impact to a minimum.

The careful cultivation practices in place naturally result in an increase in the work undertaken in the vineyards and cellars.

Driven by their principles of ensuring quality and authenticity for each vintage and terroir, Erwan and Eve Faiveley, with the support of Jérôme Flous – Chief Winemaker - have decided to go one step further in their ethos.

For over a year the Domaine has been adhering to the HVE model and obtaining HVE level 3 certification on the 11 December 2019 is a new achievement for the domaine. This certification is based on performance obligations which are measured by environmental performance indicators (certifying body: OCACIA).

In detail

HVE is a system implemented by the Grenelle Environment Forum. Its aim is to promote an agro-ecological approach and support farmers in their transition towards prioritising biodiversity and the autonomy of agricultural holdings. This certification is also a response to increasing consumer demand for produce with a low environmental impact.

The HVE framework is multi-sector and covers all forms of agricultural production. With regards to viticulture, the approach comprises 4 key areas: preserving biodiversity, phytosanitary strategy, fertilisation management and water resource management.

We have been awarded HVE level 3 which is the highest level of the certification.
