# Introduction

**I am pleased to introduce you to the Maisons Marques et Domaines 2021 Price List, effective from Monday 8th March.**

We are very aware of the immense pressure that the hospitality industry is currently enduring as a result of C-19 and we have therefore worked hard with our Principals and producers to provide as much stability on pricing as possible but it has been necessary to pass on additional Brexit related costs. While we recognise that restrictions have impacted our industry as a whole and will continue to be necessary during the year, we remain hopeful that a more normal rhythm, pattern and pace of trade, and everyday life, will begin to return in the second half of the year.

There are a number of producer milestones, new releases and launches taking place this year. The highlights of which will be the release of Cristal 2013 in the Spring and Vinothèque 2000 in the autumn among other developments from Champagne Louis Roederer to be announced later in the year. This Spring will also see the introduction from Ramos Pinto of a new limited production table wine from Quinta de Ervamoira, followed by an even rarer port later this year. Having welcomed Ornellaia into the portfolio during the latter part of 2020, we are very pleased to be offering the highly anticipated Ornellaia 2018 in April while also in Italy, fifth-generation Pio Cesare will celebrate its 140th Anniversary with the release of limited edition Barolos.

2021 also marks our 35th Anniversary and we had hoped to launch the year, as we usually do, at our Annual Tasting in January but sadly, conditions did not allow. It is our intention to reschedule in early Autumn which we hope to be able to confirm during the summer. In the meantime, our attention will be focussed on working closely with you to ensure we all make the most of the opportunities that 2021 will hold in store for us as we look forward to the prospect of seeing you and raising a glass in the not too distant future.

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# Champagne Louis Roederer



Hand in hand with  
nature



Champagne Louis Roederer was established in 1776 and remains under the ownership of the Rouzaud family to this day. With over 240 hectares of vineyards located exclusively in Grands and Premiers Crus villages, Champagne Louis Roederer is self-sufficient for approximately 75% of their non-vintage production and 100% of their vintage champagnes.

The current CEO is Frédéric Rouzaud, 7th generation of the Roederer family. Jean-Baptiste Lécaillon has been the Chef de Cave since 1999, and with the encouragement of the Rouzaud family, has introduced innovative new practices, including the introduction of biodynamic farming, a private vine nursery, an experimental vineyard, massale selection, a zero dosage champagne, a late release Cristal and the introduction of the Cristal Vinothèque.

The house has been experimenting with organic and biodynamic viticulture since 2000. All of their vines are now farmed organically making them the largest farmers of organic vines in the region. 115 hectares are certified organic and those same 115 hectares are, in fact, farmed biodynamically. The remaining 125 hectares are farmed organically but certified sustainable with zero herbicides. Research, innovation and sustainability are cornerstones of the Roederer philosophy.

Champagne Louis Roederer makes a range of styles, including: Brut Premier NV, Brut Vintage, Rosé Vintage, Blanc de Blancs, Carte Blanche NV demi sec, Brut Nature Vintage and Brut Nature Rosé Vintage, the latter two made in collaboration with designer Philippe Starck.

Cristal is the ultimate Cuvée de Prestige, first created in 1876 for Tsar Alexander II of Russia. The bottle, made from clear glass with a flat base has become iconic, and is instantly recognisable around the world. Only made in the best vintages, Cristal has become synonymous with quality, elegance and longevity.

## Quartet

Champagne Louis Roederer produces traditional method sparkling wine at the Roederer Estate winery, nestled in Mendocino County's cool, fog-shrouded Anderson Valley. Quartet builds upon centuries of Louis Roederer winemaking experience and has established a reputation as one of California's premier sparkling wines.

Jean-Claude Rouzaud selected the 235ha Anderson Valley vineyard and winery site in 1982. The Anderson Valley offers a cool climate and well-drained soils which are ideally suited to Louis Roederer's winemaking style. Roederer Estate produces Quartet from 100% Estate grown fruit and they are constantly increasing their organic and biodynamic grape growing in order to maximise quality and preserve the local environment. All fruit is grown sustainably and the vineyards and winery are Fish Friendly Certified to reflect the Estate's commitment to local waterways.

## Domaine Anderson

Jean-Claud Rouzaud discovered this remote corner of Mendocino County in 1980s, recognising it as the perfect location to grow Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes for still wines.

Domaine Anderson is 100% sustainable and is committed to maintaining and nurturing the local environment. The winery has introduced biodynamic and organic farming to their vineyards and is experimenting with "insectaries" and bee colonies to increase biodiversity and to preserve the health of the land for generations to come. Furthermore, the Domaine Anderson Wines are made from 100% estate grown fruit. Carpe Diem is produced by the Roederer Estate winemaking team and all grapes are sourced from the Estate.

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# Merry Edwards



Russian River  
Valley, California

**Merry Edwards is like her wines – an intricate blend of artistic vision and scientific training, with a passion for the natural environment.**

Her training began with an MA in Food Science and Enology from UC Davis. She worked as Winemaker at Mt Eden Vineyards and Matanzas Creek, before becoming a Consultant, all the while carefully exploring and acquiring vineyards of her own in the Russian River Valley, discovering small sites which, with the right rootstock, clone and farming techniques, produce exceptional quality grapes.

Sustainability is 'a way of life' at Merry Edwards, who have been Certified Sustainable since 2017. Merry believes that "terroir is not simply longitude, latitude and soil type, but also reflects the input of the farmer". These 'inputs' include organic composts, biodegradable vineyard products, 'a bevy of roses', insect-friendly cover crops, and flower borders, which act as natural pest control. Deficit irrigation only feeds the vines during times of water stress, all green waste is recycled back into the estate and the winery has been 100% powered by solar energy since panels were installed in 2010. As well as this, all wines are vegetarian and vegan.

With five decades of winemaking experience behind her, Merry has long had the universal respect of winemaking peers, grape growers and scholars alike. Her pioneering work in clonal research has forever changed the Californian wine industry, and her UCD clone 37, or "Merry Edwards Selection", has been a star performer in the Russian River valley since she established it in 1975.

Family remains at the heart of production at Merry Edwards, which was family run until it was taken over by Champagne Louis Roederer in 2019, who are committed to maintaining the same core values of Estate driven, quality production, family ownership and a passion for sustainability and stewardship which unite the two wineries: "In Frédéric, I have found a true soulmate to pass on the company to which I have devoted my life these past 21 years. I know my legacy is in good hands".

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# Diamond Creek

A pioneer of  
“Cabernet Crus”  
in Napa Valley,  
California





In the 1960s, Al Brounstein bought a plot of land in what is now known as Diamond Mountain District, to the north of Napa Valley. Since then, Al's vision and tenacity has led Diamond Creek Vineyards to produce some of the most sought after, iconic wines from California.

Inspired by a wine appreciation class which he took at the age of 40, Al decided to quit his job as a salesman to pursue a new calling - to emulate his two favourite wine regions, Bordeaux and Burgundy, in Napa, California.

Brounstein knew that Pinot Noir was not suited to the warm Napa Climate, so he went to Bordeaux to gather cuttings of Cabernet Sauvignon that would thrive in California. His enthusiasm was contagious and two Cru Classé properties agreed to give him some cuttings, which he then smuggled back to Napa, an endeavour which took seven return trips in his own plane!

Al then started looking for the perfect site to grow them on. Although virtually all Napa's vineyards were planted on the valley floor at the time, Al was determined that his grapes would grow best on hillsides. Full of hope that his instincts were correct, Al and his wife Boots bought 32 hectares of prune trees, rocks and overgrown shrubs at a fraction of the price that prime Napa land would fetch today.

On closer examination, Al and Boots discovered that they had bought land with three distinct "terroirs": One side of the land was made up of volcanic ash from the now extinct Mount Kanati, the other comprised of iron-rich red dirt, while the remainder contained gravel alluvial soils rich in marine fossils. The pair were delighted to discover that their land was made up of such different "terroirs" and decided to name their three principal vineyards, and resultant wines, after them. This site-specific, Burgundian "Cru" approach to making Cabernet Sauvignon in California was revolutionary. The wines have been made using the same small scale, hand-made approach from the beginning, always from 100% estate grown fruit.

Diamond Creek was bought by Champagne Louis Roederer in 2020, who look forward to preserving the legacy established by Al and Boots, through the same ethos of estate driven production, family ownership and quality driven production that unites these two iconic producers.

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# Ramos Pinto

A new era for the  
Douro, since 1880

Ramos Pinto was founded in 1880 by brothers Adriano and Antonio, bringing a new era of quality wine production to the Douro. Ramos Pinto's long and distinguished history was further strengthened when the house became part of the Louis Roederer Family in 1990 who share the family history, focus on quality and investment in the future. Today, Adriano and Antonio's descendants Jorge and Ana Rosas continue their pioneering spirit and search for the highest quality in the Douro.

By maintaining the balance between innovation and respect for tradition the house continues to go from strength to strength and today is a reference point for quality wines and port in the Douro. Having undertaken a self-production policy, Ramos Pinto only produce wine and port with grapes from its own four estates understanding early that the quality of their wine and port depends on the terroir of the Douro and having total control and deep

knowledge of their land.

Quinta do Bom Retiro and Quinta da Urtiga, are located in Cima Corgo, while Quinta dos Bons Ares and Quinta de Ervamoira, are in the Douro Superior. 286 hectares in total are planted to vines. The grapes from Ervamoira give structure and intensity of fruit, while Bom Retiro and Urtiga add complexity and elegance to the blends. It is this knowledge of the terroirs of the Douro, combined with pioneering viticulture, strict production policy and selection of only the best grape varieties that result in the production of world class Tawny and age worthy Vintage Ports, alongside the highest quality wines from the Douro.

Looking to the future, Ramos Pinto is working towards implementing organic farming and increasing biodiversity in the vineyards to improve the bond between nature and the environment and continuing the legacy of producing the highest quality Port and Douro wines.

# Domaines Ott\*



Bandol and Côtes  
de Provence, France



**Domaines Ott\* was founded in 1912 by Marcel Ott, an agricultural engineer from Alsace who dreamed of establishing a great wine estate near the Mediterranean. He proceeded to found estates in both the Bandol and Côtes de Provence appellations, estates which have gained iconic status and produce some of the finest rosés in the world.**

Domaines Ott\* has been farmed organically from the beginning. Stringent cultivation techniques are practiced using natural fertilizers and manual debudding for restrictive volume yields. The grapes are hand picked, followed by strict and selective sorting and an extremely delicate pressing process of whole bunches with a super short maceration to produce Ott\*'s signature light pink colour. Slow fermentation takes place in thermo-regulated vats then ageing in oak casks. Bottling is done the following spring. These are just some of the reasons why this wine has acquired the reputation of being one of the finest and most sought-after vintage rosés in the world.

Domaines Ott\* was managed by Marcel's descendants until 2004, when the Estates were purchased by Champagne Louis Roederer to add to their impressive portfolio of iconic Domaines. Several Ott family members still remain involved in the winery and vineyards.

Clos Mireille, in Côtes de Provence, devotes 50 hectares to the

production of rosé in the Saignée method and Blanc de Blancs from a blend of Sémillon and Rolle. The Blanc de Blancs is fresh and bright, with tangerine, peach and quince on the palate and a moreish finish. It is the perfect summer white.

Château Romassan, situated at the foot of the village of Le Castellet in the heart of the Bandol, produce stunning rosé and red wines from a blend of local varieties. The Château Romassan Rosé has been dubbed 'one of France's greatest Rosés' by Will Lyons. This is everything that you want from a Rosé – ripe berries, flowers and a touch of orange with a beautifully textured palate.

In 2020, Domaines Ott\* released a new and rare wine, Étoile, which unites the best of Domaines Ott\*'s three estates into the ultimate expression of Provence.

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# Delas Frères

Placing man and  
wine at the heart  
of the terroir



**Founded 160 years ago in the heart of the northern Rhône, Delas Frères crafts world class wines from both the northern and southern Rhône.**

The winery was founded in 1835 by Philippe Delas and Charles Audibert, and passed on to Philippe's two sons (one of which married Charles' daughter) who changed the name of the maison to Delas Frères in the early 1920s and established this name as one synonymous with high quality. In 1993 Delas Frères became part of the Champagne Louis Roederer group, which shares a similar family owned history and pursuit of excellence. 2020 saw the completion of a new state of the art winery and house in Tain Hermitage where all of the top appellation wines are vinified and aged, underlying their commitment to producing the highest quality wines.

The Domaine cultivates vineyards on the steep granite slopes of the

northern Rhône. Now owning 30 hectares of prime vineyards in the northern Rhône, including 10 hectares on the famed Hermitage hill, the team adapt their growing practices to each plot of vines to let the terroir of the Rhône shine through in the wines. Since 2013 they have been working organically, but are not certified. Additional grapes are supplied through long-term agreements with southern Rhône growers dedicated to providing only top quality grapes.

Crafted by winemakers Jacques Grange and Claire Darnaud, the wines from Delas Frères epitomise finesse and elegance. Recent vintages from the vineyards of Hermitage, Crozes-Hermitage, Chateauneuf-du-Pape, Côte Rôtie, Condrieu, Côtes-du-Rhône and Ventoux have been lauded in the press for their intensity of flavour and excellent value and are regarded as some of the most refined in the region.

**Founded in 1689 by Pierre de Rauzan, the vineyard acquired its name a few years later when his daughter Thérèse received it as part of her dowry on her marriage to Jacques de Pichon Longueville, the first President of the Parliament of Bordeaux.**

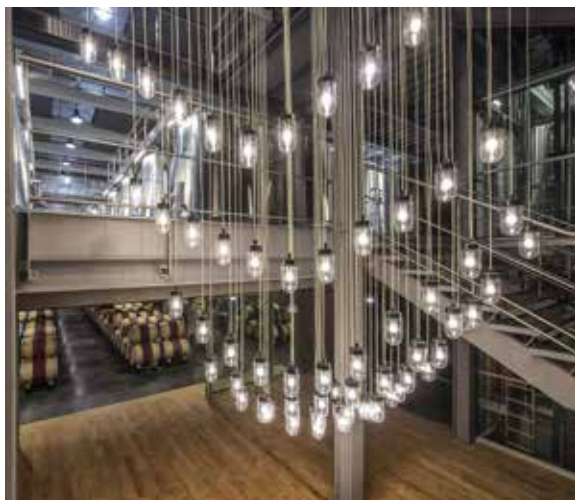
In 1850 the Pauillac estate was divided between Baron Joseph's children, Raoul and Virginie. Virginie married Count Henri de Lalande, giving her the title Comtesse de Lalande, and took over control of the Domaine. She became known for her passion and skill, and left her mark on this historic estate. In the 1855 classification Château Pichon Longueville Comtesse de Lalande acquired the status of Deuxième Cru Classé.

Continuing the tradition of family ownership, Champagne Louis Roederer took over the controlling

share of Pichon Comtesse in November 2006.

The vineyards at Pichon border the property of Château Latour and stretch south of Pauillac towards the Commune of St Julien, where a combination of soil and microclimate results in wines with inimitable concentration, complexity and charm.

Champagne Louis Roederer's on-going investment has seen the Château completely renovated, with a state-of-the-art chais completed in 2014, and the rebuilding and modernisation of the Château's wine making facilities. Nicolas Glumineau joined as Directeur General in 2013 bringing his exceptional skill as a winemaker to the team and the Chateau has flourished under his stewardship.

### Château de Pez

Château de Pez is situated in Saint-Estèphe, on the Left Bank of the Gironde. The Pontac family, who also created Haut-Brion, recognised the extraordinary potential of the gravel rich soils and purchased the property in 1585, gradually turning it from farm land to vineyards. The property remained in the hands of the family's descendants until the French Revolution, when it was sold as a property of the state.

Champagne Louis Roederer purchased the Château de Pez estate in June 1995 and immediately set about improving the vineyards and cellars. 1996 was the first vintage produced entirely under the new ownership, and quality has been improving ever since.

Since 2005 extensive research and restructuring of the vineyards has led to a better match between the vines, rootstocks and the soils, with an increase in the proportion of Cabernet Sauvignon. There are currently 42 hectares under vine with the aim of raising this to 45 hectares. There are a few hectares of experimental biodynamic vines.

In 2020 they completed the construction of a new vat room and a new barrel cellar to accommodate the move to a 'parcelaire' approach and to encourage a softer extraction of tannins from the new conical stainless-steel vats.

### Château Haut-Beauséjour

In 1992, Champagne Louis Roederer discovered two properties in the heart of Saint-Estèphe – Château Picard and Château Beauséjour – both of which received Cru Bourgeois status in 1932. Together, the pair formed an estate of 27 hectares of vineyards, which was renamed Château Haut-Beauséjour.

Champagne Louis Roederer drew up a quality charter for Château Haut-Beauséjour, encompassing vine size, debudding, green harvesting, a return to manual harvesting and double grape selection. They sold off parcels of vineyards they felt couldn't meet their quality expectations in order to enhance the wines they were determined to make. In 1993, the cellars and cuverie were entirely renovated with top-of-the-range equipment installed at the Château.

A love of wine has been passed on from one Faiveley generation to the next for nearly two centuries. The Domaine has always remained in the same family and today Erwan and Eve, the 7th generation of the Faiveley family, are at the helm and are keen to respect the traditions and savoir-faire of the family while looking to the future.

Domaine Faiveley believes that the quality of the wines comes from the fruit. To make sure they are able to get the best fruit and resulting wines, the team has invested in separate winemaking and viticulture teams in the Côte d'Or and Côte Chalonnaise, fine-tuned their barrel selection, and built a state-of-the-art winery in Mercurey. Last year, the family completed the renovation of their cellars in the heart of Nuits-St-Georges.

An impressive 80% of Domaine Faiveley's wines are made from fruit grown in the family's vineyards, and nearly all of its Côte d'Or and Côte Chalonnaise wines. With six Monopole vineyards (totalling 38% of the Domaines own vineyards) and vineyards in the most prestigious Crus – Batard Montrachet, Corton, Corton-Charlemagne, Mazis-Chambertin, Chambertin Clos de Bèze, Latricières-Chambertin, Musigny, Échezeaux and Clos Vougeot – Domaine Faiveley produce wines that showcase the qualities of each vineyard site.

The result is classic Burgundies with wonderful longevity, aromatics and an unique, elegant style. Recognised as one of the finest producers in Burgundy, the Domaine continues to go from strength to strength under Erwan and Eve.

**Domaine Billaud-Simon is renowned for producing some of the best wines in Chablis, long recognised for their steely, mineral style. Founded in 1815, the estate today is owned by the Faiveley family of famed Burgundian producer, Domaine Faiveley.**

Domaine Billaud-Simon owns 17 hectares of vineyards in some of the best areas in Chablis, with four grand cru (Les Clos, Les Preuses, Vaudesir and Les Blanchots), as well as four premier cru, (Montée de Tonnerre, Mont-de-Milieu, Fourchaume and Vaillons). The domaine has long been known for its focused, mineral-driven wines thanks to meticulous viticulture in the best sites along with the latest winemaking technology.



Most of the domaine's wines see only a touch of oak, apart from the Premier Cru Mont de Milieu which is 40% vinified in oak and the Grand Cru Les Blanchots, which is 100% vinified in oak. Billaud-Simon seek to produce a crisp, mineral style of Chablis with finesse, purity and balance. They are delicious when young, yet offer great ageing potential – the high acidity is complimented by richness of fruit, particularly in the Grand Crus which will typically improve in bottle for at least a decade. These are crisp, mineral-laden wines that are superb examples of modern style, unoaked Chablis.

# Domaines Schlumberger



Family vigneron  
and winemakers  
since 1810



**Domaines Schlumberger was founded in 1810 by Nicolas Schlumberger, who established vineyards on the renowned slopes above the town of Guebwiller. The winery is now run by the 6th and 7th generations of the same family.**

These vineyard sites have a long history of viticulture, having been planted since 207 AD.

Domaines Schlumberger's vineyards include four Grand Cru sites (Saering, Kessler, Kitterlé and Spiegel) which contribute to more than 50% of total production. Yields are kept deliberately low, with a clear focus on producing top quality wines with optimum purity of fruit. It is often a necessity on the steeper slopes of light, sandy soil which can be as steep as 60 degrees gradient. The vines are horizontally planted in rows, protected by 50 kilometres of hand built, dry-stone walls to prevent soil erosion. The vineyards have ideal exposure (south to south east) and a cooling breeze, allowing the organically farmed grapes, to reach optimum maturity. Domaines Schlumberger is a certified Level 3 (the top level) High Environmental Producer and has been 100% sustainable since 2003.

Domaines Schlumberger's Princes Abbés range was named after the Prince Abbots who owned the vineyard from the 9th to the 18th century. This range blend includes

a high proportion of fruit from the young Grand Cru vines. With the focus on the expression of classic varietal characteristics, similar to the second wines of the great châteaux of Bordeaux, Les Princes Abbés range delivers a taste of Grand Cru wines at an everyday approachable style.

Alain Beydon-Schlumberger runs the winery with his nephew, Thomas, and niece, Séverine. Alain Freyburger joined the team in 1995 and has been Cellar Master since 2000, working closely alongside Vineyard Manager, Michel Otterman.

Marqués de Murrieta was one of the first Rioja Houses to be established, in 1852, by Luciano Francisco Ramón de Murrieta one of the founding fathers of modern Rioja winemaking. Luciano, drawing on his experiences in France, felt that to make the best wines in the world the grapes needed to come from a single estate, which guaranteed complete control over the grapes, and established the Ygay Estate near Logroño in Rioja Alta. Luciano was a leader in using French techniques to develop greater complexity and longevity from Tempranillo, Rioja's indigenous red grape.

Vicente Dalmau, Count of Creixell, continues this tradition and respect for the unique land of Finca Ygay. Today the estate covers 300 hectares and the philosophy is one of quality, with low yields in the vineyard and limited production in

the winery which are the key to the quality and style of Marqués de Murrieta wines. The vineyards are divided into several smaller plots, including the single vineyards of Capellania, Canajas (from which the grapes for Dalmau hail, including a small plot of old vine Cabernet Sauvignon) and La Plana, the home of the esteemed Castillo Ygay, which was voted the number one wine in the world by Wine Spectator last year. These are truly handmade, world class wines from the oldest family owned estate in Rioja.

Marqués de Murrieta also own Pazo Barrantes, the ancestral home to the Creixell family. Pazo Barrantes' twelve hectares of Albariño vineyards surround a stunning 16th century Galician Palace in the Salnés valley, just a few kilometres from the Atlantic coast. These wines set the benchmark for quality Albariño from Rias Baixas

Since its inception, Ornellaia's production has been influenced and inspired by the Mediterranean character of the coast near Bolgheri. Founded in 1981, Ornellaia has helped establish this relatively young viticultural area and it is now regarded as one of the world's most iconic estates.

Painstaking attention to detail, both in the vineyards and in the winery, allows Ornellaia to release extremely elegant interpretations of each vintage.

Nestled in the foothills near Bolgheri, Ornellaia lies just a few kilometres from the Mediterranean coast. During the summer months, the cool sea breeze caresses the vineyards and nearby olive groves, while during the winter the hills

provide protection from the cold north winds. Ornellaia believes that a wine should be the most authentic expression of the terroir from which it originates and it is right here that, together with the maritime climate, the heterogeneous nature of the land and the soil – of marine, alluvial and volcanic origin – a distinct environment is created. One where red and white varieties can best express themselves.

Sustainable viticulture is an integral part of their philosophy and is based on the quality of the soil, and thus the grapes, economic longevity and the enhancement of their heritage. They nurture their land, and the landscape of the Bolgheri area along with its historical, cultural and ecological features.

**This historic family-owned estate is named after its founder Cesare Pio, who established the business in 1881. Celebrating the 140th anniversary this year, the winery remains a family affair and continues to be based in Alba, in the heart of Piemonte.**

Pio Cesare developed Barolo's reputation overseas in the 1950s by being one of the first producers to export the wine to the UK. Today, the founder's great grandson Pio Boffa continues the family tradition, together with his daughter Federica, producing Piemontese wines in a style that manages to balance the best of the old with the best of the new.



Pio Cesare owns 70 hectares of vineyards in the hills of Barolo and Barbaresco, including some of the prime sites for growing Nebbiolo: Serralunga and Monforte in Barolo and Treiso in Barbaresco.

Under the tenure of Pio Boffa, the winery have added a range of single vineyard wines: Barolo Ornato, Barolo Mosconi, Barbaresco 'Il Bricco', Barbera 'Fides' and 'Piodilei' Chardonnay. These wines are only produced in limited quantities and offer a more modern interpretation of some of the great individual sites in Piemonte.

# Tommasi Family Estates

Viticulturists since  
1902



Tommasi was founded in 1902 and is located in Pedemonte, in the heart of the historic Valpolicella Classico region. From grandfather Giacomo's small vineyard holding, the Tommasi estate has developed over the years becoming one of the most recognised producers of Valpolicella and Lugana.

The family owns vineyards in some of the prime hillside sites in the region and it is now managed by the 4th generation of the Tommasi family. An attentive ear to change, respect of place, and high-quality production are three driving factors that put Tommasi among Italy's leading producers. Their expertise in crafting classic Amarone, reached the pinnacle in the newly launched De Buris project, a single vineyard, long aged expression of Amarone.

The family's passion for wine, lead them to acquire properties in some of the prime viticultural areas in

Italy. Masseria Surani is one of the estates in the Tommasi portfolio, a winery in the heart of the Salento, Manduria.

Manduria is one of the finest zones for the cultivation of the Primitivo grape, where viticulture has ancient origins, dating back to the Magna Graecia time. The inspiration of the wine names comes from the Greek Mythology, as the region of Puglia was colonised by the ancient Greeks in 700 BC.

The other project that has seen the Tommasi family involved is the esteemed Paternoster estate. One of the most important wineries in the Basilicata region of Southern Italy, Paternoster extends over 20 hectares divided into several crus of very old vineyards, planted between 450 and 600m altitude. The Vulture's unique terroir is expressed in fabulously concentrated and long-lived Aglianico and mineral Falanghina.

## CASTIGLION DEL BOSCO

**Brunello di Montalcino made history in 1980 by being the first Italian wine to be awarded DOCG status. To earn this title, Brunello must be produced exclusively from Sangiovese Grosso grapes grown in Montalcino, aged a minimum of 24 months in oak, and a further 24 months in bottle before release.**

Castiglion del Bosco started producing wine in 1954, and is one of the founding members of the 'Consorzio del Vino Brunello di Montalcino'. After Massimo Ferragamo purchased the estate in 2003, major investments in the vineyards and winery restored Castiglion del Bosco to its position as a leading Brunello estate.



Located in the Val d'Orcia National Park, the estate's 2,000 ha are largely occupied by dense woods of holm oak, oak, and beech, in addition to meadows, organically-farmed crops and 62 ha of vineyard planted exclusively to Sangiovese.

Cecilia Leoneschi oversees the vineyards and cellar, crafting pure and classical expressions Sangiovese. Vineyard management is strictly organic, and the wines are made using a natural approach, with minimal use of sulphites and intervention.

The Castello di Fonterutoli estate has been owned by the Marchesi Mazzei since 1435 and the family is closely linked to the history of Tuscan winemaking. At the heart of the estate there is the family-shared commitment to innovation and improvement whilst always preserving tradition, family values and the natural environment.

Located 5km south of Castellina in the heart of the Chianti Classico, Fonterutoli remains a tranquil country village, surrounded by 117 hectares of stunning vineyards rising to 500m altitude. The character of the wines of the Castello di Fonterutoli has been perfected over the years thanks to continual innovation, in harmony with the winery's culture, history and heritage of technical expertise.

Always the innovators, the Mazzei are also bringing their centuries-long expertise in winemaking to other regions of Italy. Belguardo is their Maremma estate, 34ha of vineyards on the hills between Grosseto and Montiano and next to the Tyrrhenian Sea. Strongly influenced by the vicinity to the sea, the estate allows for the cultivation of quite different grapes: local vines such as Sangiovese, Alicante, and Vermentino, alongside international ones such as Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Syrah.

The other estate in the Mazzei portfolio is located just outside the town of Noto in the south-

eastern part of Sicily. Situated at approximately 130m above sea level, the gently sloping vineyards have a west, south-west exposure. A combination of long warm summers and cooling sea breezes enable the production of elegant wines with great finesse and varietal character.

The latest project of Giovanni Mazzei is Villa Marcello, who launched his first vintage Prosecco from his mother Alessandra's family estate in the Veneto. The estate covers 57 hectares in the commune of Treviso, of which 26.5 are planted under vine. The vineyards are situated at 25 metres above sea level where silty clay soils produce structured, elegant wines. As with the other Mazzei estates, Villa Marcello is managed with minimal intervention and the utmost environmental responsibility.

**Long recognised for producing premium wines, Meerlust Estate has been the pride of the Myburgh family since 1756. The Estate is run today by Hannes Myburgh, 8th generation custodian of this 17th Century national monument.**

The first owner of the property, Henning Huising, settled there in 1693. He named his new home Meerlust, meaning 'pleasure of the sea', as the manor house sits on a granite outcrop just 5km from False Bay. The vineyards are refreshed by ocean breezes and evening mists which roll in from the coast. The grapes ripen slowly, achieving concentrated varietal flavours.

Meerlust were the pioneers of Bordeaux varietals in the Cape. When visiting Bordeaux, Nico Myburgh discovered that the

climate and soil was similar to that of the Eerste River Valley. However, at the time the red wines produced in Bordeaux and South Africa were very different: Bordeaux thrived on producing blends.

Nico returned to Meerlust, filled with the desire to create a blend of his own that would match those produced in France. In 1980, Rubicon, the new blend was born. With 70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Merlot and 10% Cabernet Franc, a new style of wine had been created in South Africa.

The Myburgh family is committed to social responsibility and has a long history of investing in their workforce through the Meerlust Foundation, which aims to provide a safe environment for the children of the farm workers.
